“A recording Fee of \$0.50 & an Event Service fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered in any
Licensed or Member Club show or Obedience trial. These fees are to be collected by the show
giving club and paid to The American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the
show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club rule,
Chapter 11, Section 2)”

There will be **NO REFUND** for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or
obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging.

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the
presence of their dog in the judging rings.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection
fee to the amount of each returned check.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian
(except where noted in Premium list) or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show
Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot be opened or be completed by reason
of riots, civil disturbances, fire and Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or
any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility or
liability for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or
property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children or spectators.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its
acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries.

Beginner Puppy 4-6 Month Competition

One combined class will be offered for Shetland Sheepdogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months of age. An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for entries A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
 Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.
 Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.* AKC Rules in *Dealing with Misconduct* will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition.

The Certificate of Merit (CM) title is an introductory title to AKC conformation events. Entrants in each breed shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. Winners of the Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds or varieties will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their breed or variety. Winners of Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds or varieties will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their sex.

The Certificate of Merit requires 15 points awarded in accordance with the following points structure.

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color) Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.) Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white) Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard)
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements of a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for the championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
